

# PASSIVE

An example:

Active	Nancy	makes	tea
	Subject	Verb	Object
Passive	Tea	is made	(by Nancy)
	Object becoming subject	Verb	Subject becoming object or dropped

As you may have guessed, for making a passive sentence we need two things:

- 1- Past participle of the verb
- 2- An object-friendly verb; a transitive verb

*“You must have had the privilege of the acquaintance with past participle so, I leave you two alone. On this note, let’s introduce you to the 2<sup>nd</sup> one”:*

A transitive verb is a verb that can or must have an object following right after; Like:

Take (something)      Meet (somebody)      Give (something)<sub>[to somebody]</sub>      Grow

On contrary, we have intransitive verbs that don’t take any object at all; like:

Go                      Jump                      Run                      Fly                      Grow
