1 <sup>st</sup> person plural	<i>We</i>	<i>Us</i>	<i>Our</i>	<i>Ours</i>	<i>Ourselves</i>
2 <sup>nd</sup> person plural	<i>You (all)</i>	<i>You</i>	<i>Your</i>	<i>Yours</i>	<i>Yourselves</i>
3 <sup>rd</sup> person plural	<i>They</i>	<i>Them</i>	<i>Their</i>	<i>Theirs</i>	<i>Themselves</i>

6. Meditate and look after **yourself** or else no one does.
7. **He, himself** told **me** **you** are really honest and liable but apparently **you (all)** are a bunch of liars.
